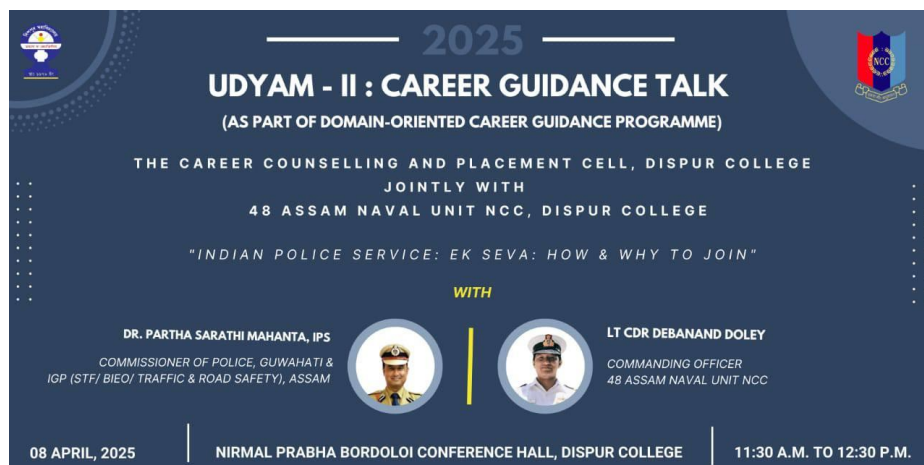
DATE: 08/04/25

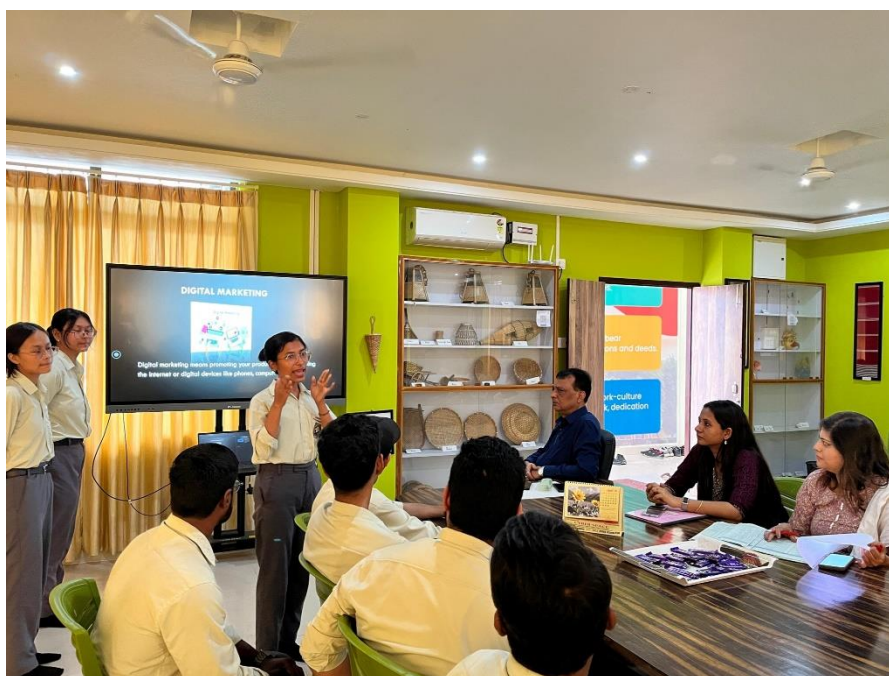


DATE: 09/04/25

Rang Ghar: Asia's oldest amphitheater.

Talatal Ghar: A four-storied structure built during the Ahom period.

Siva Dol, Vishnu Dol, and Devi Dol: Temples built by Queen Ambika during the Ahom dynasty.

We also visited Charaideo Maidams, the mound-burial system of the Ahom dynasty, was recently inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List. Charaideo is famous for being the site of numerous Moidams, which are earthen burial mounds, particularly those of the Ahom dynasty. These Moidams, sometimes referred to as the "pyramids of Assam," are considered unique and rare, serving as the final resting places of Ahom royalty. Charaideo was also the first capital of the Ahom kingdom.

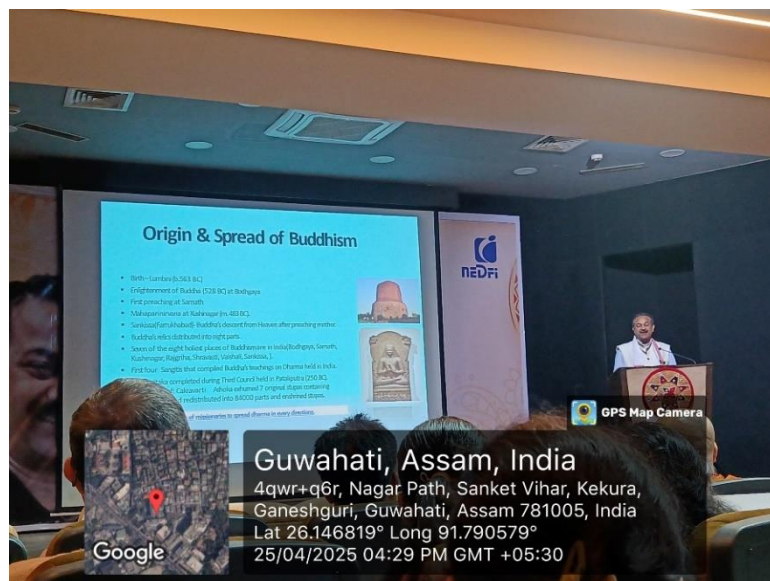
DATE: 25/04/25

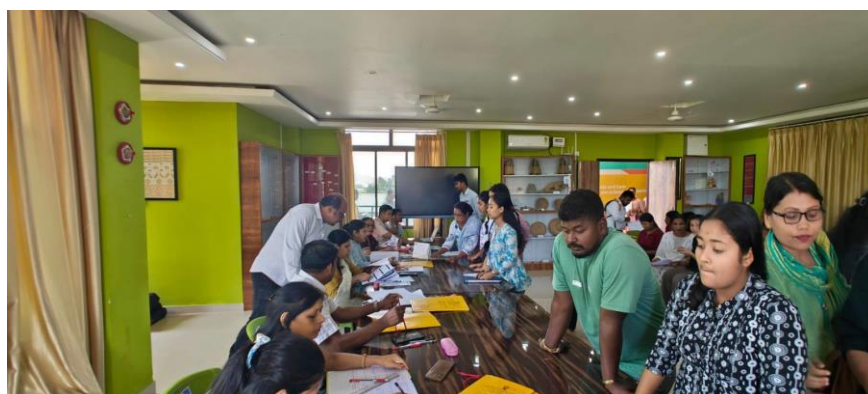

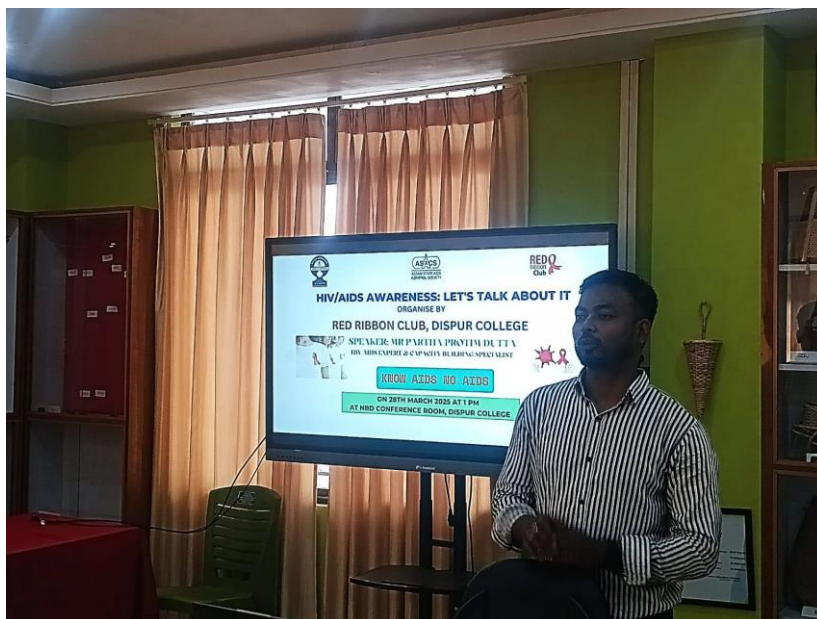
